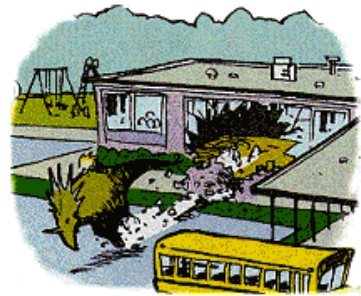

## Vocabulary and Rules:

**possessive noun: names who or what has or owns something**

Form a **singular possessive noun** by adding an apostrophe ( ' ) and **s**.

girl → girl's

Miss Hayes → Miss Hayes's

Form a **plural possessive noun** that ends in **s** by adding an apostrophe ( ' ).

boys → boys'

families → families'

Form the possessive of a plural noun that does not end in **s** by adding an apostrophe ( ' ) and **s**.

children → children's

sheep → sheep's

**Singular:**

mother

class

man

deer

**Singular Possessive:**

mother's

class's

man's

deer's



**Plural:**

mothers

classes

men

deer

**Plural Possessive:**

mothers'

classes'

men's

deer's
